

DROPPED YOUR MOBILE OR I-POD IN WATER? DON'T DESPAIR, RUSH TO THE KITCHEN!

Did your expensive mobile or I-Pod fall in water or got wet in the rain?

Warranty for most electronic gadgets does not cover damage by water. The answer is in your kitchen.

Power off the device and try to completely cover it in a bowl of rice. Rice being a natural desiccant will help absorb the extra moisture. Leave it like that for at least 24 hours and DO NOT try to charge the device.

If your gadget has a removable battery, remove it and dry it separately to speed up the whole drying process.

This will work out very cheap as compared to repairing/purchasing new unit.
