Dear Member,

This incident relates to the "career growth" of a devotee, Mrs. M. V. Rajeswari. She describes how Guruji in 1984 had blessed her with a very senior position which she could not fathom of reaching at that time. As time passed by, incidents unfolded in her career, making her climb to reach the pinnacle which Guruji had predicted and blessed her to achieve. She finally retired as an "Accountant General". The experience in verbatim is carried below.

"Dear DMS members.

My life - each and every moment of my life - is always guarded and protected by "Govardhan" Guruji. Each and every word spoken by Guruji, has more meaning than it appears prima facie. Of course, we will understand this only after a lot of personal experiences with Him. There may have been so many instances which I would not have noticed and associated them with His grace, but some instances definitely are His *Thiruvilaiyadal* (His Divine Game, in Tamil).

I wish to share one such event related to my climbing up the ladder in my career. I joined the "Indian Audit & Accounts Department" and got posted in the Office of Accountant General, Tamilnadu as an External Auditor. This was after my graduation in the year 1976. At that time, I had also an offer letter from the Reserve Bank of India. When I was in two minds, my father advised me to join the "AG" office. I joined the "AG" office as per his advice.

With Guruji's blessings over the years, I passed all departmental promotional examinations on merit and soon became an "Assistant Accounts Officer", a gazetted post.

Guruji used to have prayers on Fridays at His Mandaveli, Norton Road residence. I would join the prayers quite regularly with my two little daughters, taking them pillion on my two-wheeler. After the prayers, Guruji used to regularly address me as "AG" Raji. I used to laugh and tell Guruji, that listening to Him call me "AG" Raji, other devotees may think that I am an AG (Accountant General)! Whereas, I was only working in a department of the AG office. Guruji would then close His eyes and laugh. To become an Accountant General (AG), I should have written the tough "UPSC Central Civil Services Competitive" exam and got selected. At that time with two small children, I could not dream of preparing for the competitive exam. Further, I had crossed the age limit for eligibility.

A few years rolled by and Guruji had taken samadhi in 1991. I continued working in the AG office and had successful assignments in various wings and became the first computer faculty at all-India level in our department and got posted in the Regional Training Institute at Chennai.

In 1995, quite unexpectedly, due to shortage of IA&AS officers, C&AG of India conducted a one-time all India competitive examination through UPSC to fill up these posts. There were fifty such IA&AS positions and these were filled up from among the internal serving officers in the combined audit and accounts departments throughout India. IA&AS officers are liable for all-India transfers. So, I was hesitating to apply. But on the last day, a colleague of mine came and gave me an application form and made me apply.

At that time, my elder daughter was studying in the 10th standard and I had to take extra care of her by taking her to coaching classes, etc. In fact, she helped me a lot in the preparation of my history paper which had some portions in her syllabus. Both of us used to sit and prepare after her school/my office hours.

Out of around six lakh candidates who took the examination, 150 were to be selected in the written examination. This was further filtered to one third in the viva voce (oral examination). I took the written exam and got selected for the viva voce.

Meanwhile, as is common in a government setup, some persons had gone to court against this one-time examination and so UPSC's final selection list was locked in a court battle. Suddenly, after two years, one fine morning, one of my well-wishers and higher officers congratulated me. He informed me that UPSC had published the results of selected candidates that morning and my name was one among the coveted fifty selected officers. My joy knew no bounds and immediately Guruji's words calling me "AG Raji" rang in my ears as my immediate designation would be "Deputy Accountant General". His words had become true! I had tears of joy streaming down my face. He has made it happen!

Thus, I joined the IA&AS and became an Accountant General and worked for another 16 years as an IA&AS Officer and retired as an "Accountant General". The next wonder was that, during all those 16 years I had postings in South India only. My two daughters are now happily married and settled.

In 1984-85 itself, Guruji had decided to bless me with the AG post, which I could realize only in 1995. Even when I took the UPSC examination in 1995, it never occurred to me to link Guruji's calling me "AG Raji" with that opportunity.

This is the grace of Guruji to His devotees. My only prayer is that He should keep me and my daughters, always in His fold, and in all births to come!

Camp for women to commemorate World Women's Day falling on 8th March

The camp was held on 9th March, 2019. A total of 63 women attended.

They were given thorough general check-up, weight and blood pressure were recorded. Breast and pelvic examinations were done to detect the presence of lump masses, ulcers, etc.

About 18 of them were either obese or over-weight. All these women had knee joint pain due to body weight.

All of them were advised about the importance of self- breast examination, prevention of anaemia and osteoporosis and regular exercises and walking for reducing body weight and obesity.

The ladies disbursed after having a nutritious meal. All were given iron, calcium tablets and deworming tablets.









One lady had hypertension, one had diabetes mellitus and another had fibrocystic breast disease.
