Dear Member,

This incident happened in the 90s.

Dusk was turning to night. It must have been around 7 pm. Jas heard the door bell ring.

"Jas, Jas, my sister is missing since morning" a very distraught looking Kumar gasped (name disguised) as Jas attended to the door.

Kumar explained. "She was as usual tending to her patients at home in the morning. After finishing that she said she would go out and be back shortly. Till now she has not turned up. Parents are worried sick. Hope she is alright."

Jas (Jasminder Premani) was a Punjabi born and brought up in Chennai. One of the senior executives in the company she worked in, used to talk about Guru Kamakshi Baba. After meeting Kamakshi Baba Jas experienced His love and affection. She was witness to a couple of episodes dealt with by Him and her faith in Him became deep-rooted.

Kumar and Jas worked in the same company. Jas had joined in 1987 and Kumar in 1988. Kumar lived with his parents and had two sisters, one working abroad, and this other sister in Chennai. They belonged to a well-known industrial group of South India. Kumar was very attached to Jas. In fact she was his confidant and she was the only soul to whom he would open up his heart and talk. He was otherwise a shy person. Jas looked upon Kumar as her younger brother.

Kumar's sister was practising medicine. She was younger to Kumar. She had finished her MBBS but was not allowed to practise or work. She operated her clinic from the residence but this was only in the mornings. What was unusual about her service was that she never charged her patients anything. A long queue would form outside her house.

"Why did you not report to the police?" Jas asked. "No Jas" Kumar's response seemed guarded.

Jas's mind went to Guruji. "Kumar, I know a very great spiritual person in Chennai. He lives in Mandeveli. He will surely guide you".

Jas and Kumar dashed to Guruji's house but He had left for Kapaleeshwarar temple as He is wont to, in the evenings. There were a couple of devotees with Guruji when the two reached the temple.

Guruji prayed.

"She is presently in Tirupathi. She is in love with a person and wants to marry him. He is also a Doctor. But her parents are not consenting. Both have gone off to Tirupathi to get married. She will call the family within two days. Get her married officially when she returns. If she does not call within two days, on the third day you can give a Police complaint."

Jas was flabbergasted. "My God!" She thought, the family is conservative and this will be hard for them to take. But she was even more shocked when Kumar responded.

"Respected Sir, I am stunned by what You have said. Yes it is true she wants to marry this person very badly but he is not of the same caste. She says if she does not get to marry him, she will never marry anyone in her life. My parents being orthodox Brahmins refused. But she is adamant. We know she has been meeting the boy regularly which my parents had sternly forbidden." None of this Jas was aware of.

Kumar continued "We wanted to go the police today but if it transpires she is safe and had only gone to meet this boy, our family name will get tarnished".

Jas was getting the answer why Kumar did not want to go to the police.

"No need to go to the police. She is not in any danger. She will come back. But when she comes back get her married. She will be happy with him".

A visibly relieved Kumar took leave of Guruji and thanked Jas profusely.

Kumar reached home and narrated to his parents what Guruji said.

Next day evening in the office Kumar came over to Jas's table, relief writ large on his face. "Know what? My parents got a call from my sister. She is safe.."

"What did she say?" Jas was not expecting this quick a development. After all Guruji had said "three days.."

"She said she had gone to Tirupathi and got married to the person she loved".

"Oh. What did your parents say? Did they express their indignation?"

"No. We had accepted what Guruji advised. My parents are now okay about her getting married to this person. They asked her to come home and said for them her happiness mattered most."

The next day Kumar's sister had returned home.

The same day in the evening Kumar accompanied by his mother came to Guruji's house. She fell at His feet and wept. "We were at our wits' end when our daughter disappeared. When Kumar conveyed Your message, we could not believe that such a great soul existed who could tell us our daughter's whereabouts. We had broken down and were desperate. At the same time we did not want to go to the police. We decided to put all trust in You and heed Your advice. You have saved our family reputation".

After the girl's return the parents arranged for a reception at Chennai.

We do not have updates as such about Kumar or the family after 1991. Jas left for Mumbai in 1991 and lost touch with Kumar. Kumar proceeded to Australia for further studies. The last that she heard about the couple was that the sister and her husband were happily settled.

Guruji's affection is so-encompassing it knows no barriers. Whether you are well-known to Him or just a stranger, He will go out-of-the-way to solve the problem. He was a soul who lived for others!

This time the blessings of Lord Venkateswara have been invoked for the New Year for all DMS members. The Laddu sent along with the Satsanga is from Tirupathi itself. Anand Kumar Reddy, Chennai (Life member) has sponsored this and we thank him heartily for the gesture.

The Tamil pandit was explaining it with unction and devotion. He was hindu by religion in a christian school. All the students were christians. We loudly laughed at it, thinking how can there be miracles at all in other religions. It is impossible we thought. Miracles can take place only in my religion.

When our Tamil Pandit heard the laughter his face changed. He retorted, "you all think that only in your religion miracles take place! "

From the Doctor's Desk



A camp was held on 11th Oct. 2014 for senior citizens. Dr. Geetha Badrinath has been very concerned for them. From our experience at Village Alamadhi, *DMS* is aware they are very often uncared for, and in a few cases, unwanted at home. Medical care may be nonexistent as they are considered a liability by their children.

DMS would like to reach out to such persons and identify causes of their ill-health. We would like to counsel them for simple ways to take precautions particularly for persons suffering from diabetes.

This is the first time *DMS* is organising a camp which is dedicated to the senior citizens. 51 Senior Citizens attended the camp. They were checked, and

certain important medicines were dispensed. A general counselling session was held where one of the focus themes was control of diabetes. Annadhaanam was served.

Dr. Geetha Badrinath conducted the camp. Young Dr. G.Arun (MBBS) was the Guest Doctor. He is pursuing PG Diploma in Diabetology with MMC which is attached to General Hospital. *DMS* thanks Dr.G. Arun for his contribution to the camp.
