Dear Member,

This incident happened in 1984.

"The inauguration of the project will be early in the morning of 15th Aug. at 5.00 am. Will you be ready by then?" The GM of NTPC Ltd., asked Kumar, the Project engineer of Best & Crompton (name disguised).

"Yes of course, we will be ready" was the reply.

The GM of NTPC continued "Do you know who will be coming to do the inauguration? It will be none other than the Managing Director of NTPC. Ensure NOTHING goes wrong".

This was the contract of the sub-station project NTPC had been awarded by the Railways and sub-contracted to M/s. Best & Crompton. It was of a value of Rs. 400 crores.

The sub-station had about 500 posts all of which had electric current lines connected to a computerised Board supplied by a Japanese firm. It was so designed, even if one line has a wrong connection, the main line would trip.

Kumar was the officer at the site responsible for the successful completion of the project. The project was at Secunderabad. At that time Guruji was employed by M/s. Best & Crompton stationed at Kazipet managing overall the railway electrification project.

The inauguration was scheduled on 15th August. The site team of Best & Crompton had planned to do a trial run on 14th after completing the installation but by the time the odds and ends were put in place it was already night time. Tension ran high as next day early morning the inauguration had been scheduled.

Kumar got all his team confirmations that all aspects were verified, checked and found okay and that the stage was set for the trial run.

"ON" Kumar commanded. The supply was switched on. The main line tripped. The trial run had failed! It took some time to re-check if all steps had been completed and once again the supply

was switched on. Again it failed. The team led by Kumar began to get woked up as time was running out.

The report about the trial run was to be given to the GM of NTPC. He blew his top. It was already 1 am on 15th August and there were barely four hours left for the inauguration to take place.

Kumar was an ardent devotee of Guruji and had faith in Guruji. Desperate, he called up Guruji at that late hour and lamented saying his position would become very shaky if the inauguration failed.

Guruji was at that time sleeping in his room at Kazipet. He woke up on hearing the phone ring and took the call.

"Please give me a minute. I will pray and tell you. Call me back". Guruji told Kumar.

Guruji prayed. After exactly a minute as the phone rang a second time, Guruji picked up. Kumar was waiting with his heart in his mouth. "There is a fault in Post number 401". Guruji's voice sounded clear and unambiguous. "A wrong connection has been given there. If you rectify that the test run will be successful. Do not worry. You will do fine". Kumar knew the problem was already solved with this.

The mistake in Post number 401 was rectified and the trial run was successful. The inauguration, scheduled at 5 am went as planned without a hitch.

Later the GM of NTPC learnt about this miraculous intervention of Guruji from Kumar. He was very impressed and at the same time became curious to meet Guruji. At a later stage, he himself became a very ardent devotee of Guruji. There is one instance of his devotion that we know of, which is indeed very moving.

There are probably hundreds of instances where Guruji has been able to 'view' the state of affairs of devotees at other locations and guide the devotees. The more important of these which are known to us are being narrated in Satsanga. We have seen other instances too in the activity called 'Sound therapy' where prayer meetings were organised to heal patients through mantras such as Rudram. (These were done once a month). After visiting the hospital/house, Guruji would ask the patient/parents what happened. Then He would close His eyes and 'see' the problem with His spiritual powers. He would then give the 'real' diagnosis which could substantially vary from what the parents said.
