This instance that took place between 1962-1966 was narrated by Mukund mama, elder brother of Guruji.

One among them was Seshagiri Rao (Reddy) more popularly known as Giri Babu (now in USA having his own business of pharmacy). His brother Sudhakara Reddy was running a chain of shops. One day Sudhakara Reddy's wife brought a young girl, her classmate, a graduate by name Manju and a very good Kuchipudi dancer.

Manju told Kamakshi Baba "I am a Kuchipudi dancer. I want to perform dance programs in sabhas . There are many offers, and opportunities do seem to be aplenty, but the offers have strings attached. Not everything is professional. I want to be pure in character to build my profession. Kindly bless me to have good progress in this profession and to be prosperous."

Kamakshi Baba understood her plight and felt very sorry for her. He gave her one 10 paise coin (coin as was in vogue at that time) and blessed her saying that she will achieve material and spiritual progress and rise to become famous in her profession.

This lady is none other than Manju Barggavee, who today has given over 1600 solo and ballet performances in India as also all over the world. She shot into the limelight after her role in the nationally and internationally acclaimed blockbuster musical film **SHANKARABHARANAM**.

The Telugu University has conferred on her the title of 'Uttam Sahiti Murthy', whilst the Government of Karnataka has conferred on her 'Rajyotsava Award'. In 91-92 she won the Sri Vedantam Jaganath Sharma Vamsee Berkeley award.

She is just one example of personalities who shot into stardom/fame after coming to Shri Kamakshi Baba.

Sunil – interesting case study

In one of the previous issues of Satsanga I had discussed two interesting cases that had been handled by us – Prasad and Vishnu. In this issue I wish to brief you about another interesting patient – Sunil. When Sunil came to us he was just two months old. He was brought to us with the complaint of wheezing. The baby was having repeated episodes of wheezing, not responding to conventional treatment.

We had investigations done. The investigations revealed that the baby had Total Anomalous pulmonary venous drainage (TAPV), a rare condition in which purified blood from the lungs instead of returning to the left atrium was going to the right. So the baby will be getting only impure blood supply to the whole body. Such babies will usually be blue (cyanosis). Peculiarly this particular baby was pink and not blue and hence the difficulty in identifying.

We needed to carry out more elaborate investigations. This was organized at MMM Hospital at Mugappair. Corrective surgery was performed and normal blood flow was established.

Today baby Sunil is robust and healthy like any other child.

The incidence of TAPV is 1 in 1 lakh.
